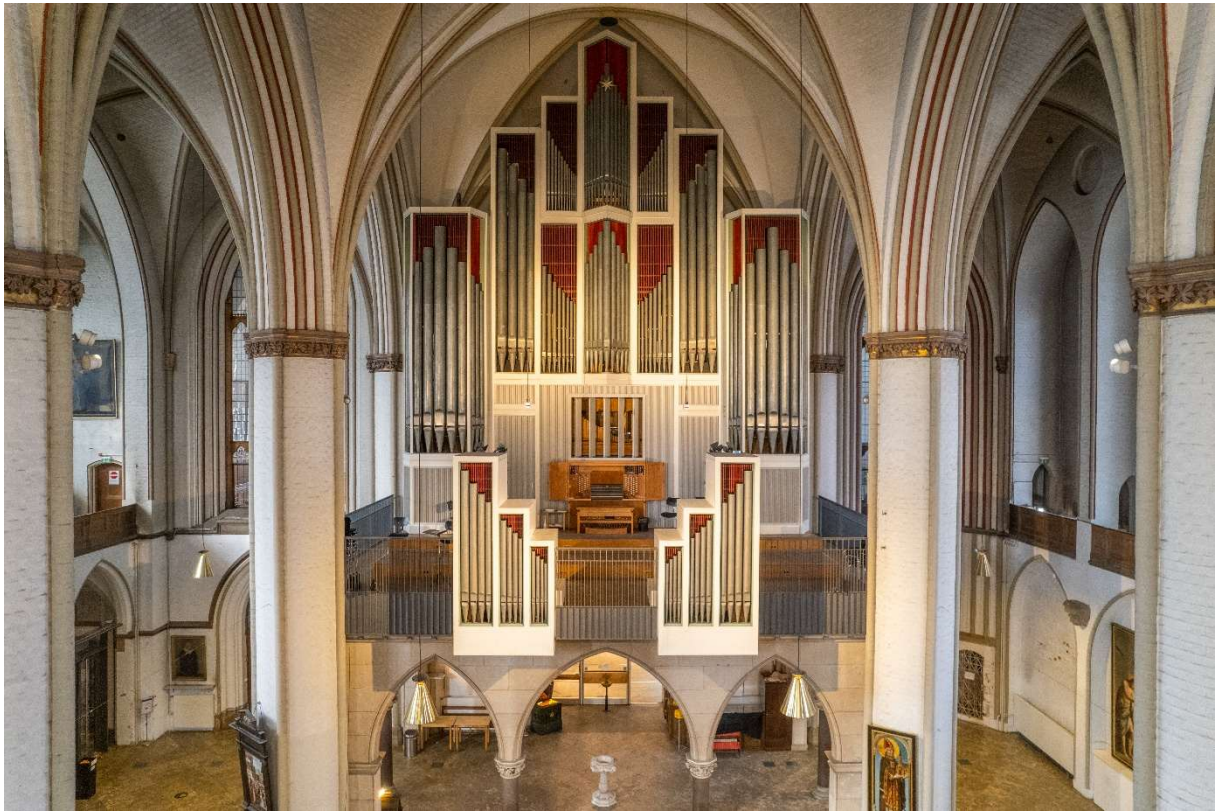


Organs and organ music in St. Petri



St. Peter's has three organs from the workshop of Rudolf von Beckerath. With four manuals, 66 stops and 4,724 pipes, the Great Organ is one of the largest and most beautiful-sounding in Hamburg. In addition to church services, it can be heard in the weekly hour of church music and in the summer international organ concerts.

The restoration and extension of the Great Organ by Alexander Schuke Orgelbau, Potsdam, was completed in 2006.

The two smaller organs in the church were completely overhauled in 2007 and 2008. Since 2012, St. Petri has also had a chest organ by Henk Klop (Garderen, Netherlands) with 3 1/2 stops.
